**88/17 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE**

An apology for absence was received from Mrs. T. Field.

**89/17 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

Mr. S. Powell and Mr. L. Smith declared an interest in item 92/17 and left the meeting whilst it was discussed.

**90/17 MINUTES**

The Chairman was authorised to sign as a correct record the Minutes of the meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> December, 2017.

**91/17 MATTERS ARISING**

**(a) Public Toilets, Llanyre (Ref. Min. 76/17(a))**

The lock has been replaced but the sign is yet to be erected.

**(b) Public Toilets, Newbridge-on-Wye (Ref. Min. 76/17(b))**

Correspondence was received from One Voice Wales confirming that it was their responsibility to lobby the Welsh Assembly Government for funding to support public toilets and they would add these toilets to their list for support.

**(c) Newbridge-on-Wye Recycling Site (Ref. Min. 76/17(c))**

Nothing further to report.

**(d) Llanyre Recreation Field:**

(i) Recreation Field (Ref. Min. 76/17(d)(i)) – the Clerk reported that no response had been received from PCC. However, it was now reported that the whole ditch was in need of clearing. Members agreed to investigate and report back to the next meeting.

(ii) Play Area (Ref. Min. 76/17(d)(ii)) – a quotation in the sum of £175 was received for the removal of the tree. No response had been received from other contractors who had been contacted. It was, therefore, agreed that the quotation be accepted and the contract requested to proceed. It was also agreed that the wood chippings be used in Pritchard Recreation Ground.

- (iii) Pritchard Recreation Ground (Ref. Min. 76/17(d)(iii)) – it was reported that water was still flooding through and not going down the big drain. It was agreed that the Local Member be requested to contact PCC to request the return of the contractors. Mr. H. Lewis had removed the tree and was thanked by the Chairman.
- (e) Newbridge-on-Wye Playing Field (Ref. Min. 76/17(e)) – no response from PCC regarding the mole infestation.
- (f) Vacancy (Ref. Min. 76/17(f)) – the Clerk distributed copies of notices advertising the vacancy in Llanyre.
- (g) Llanyre Church Hall (Ref. Min. 76/17(j)) – nothing further to report.
- (h) Vehicle Activated Speed Signs (Ref. Min. 79/17(a)) – no response received.
- (i) Powys Waste Service (Ref. Min. 79/17(e)) – clarification was received and it was confirmed that responsibility for Health and Safety on recycling sites would be the sole responsibility of PCC. Members, therefore, agreed to sign the new contract.

Cerrigroes, Llanyre – erection of an extension to the existing free range egg unit. It was noted that this was an extension between the two existing sheds to join them together.
