118/18 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence were received from Mr. S. Powell, Mr. M. Watkins and Mrs. P. Stevenson.

119/18 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were none.

120/18 MINUTES

The Chairman was authorised to sign as a correct record the Minutes of the meeting held on 27th February, 2018 and of the extra ordinary meeting held on 6th March, 2018.

121/18 MATTERS ARISING

Meeting held on 27th February, 2018

(a) Public Toilets, Llanyre (Ref. Min. 107/17(a))

Electricity – 44688 Water – 634

(b) Public Toilets, Newbridge-on-Wye (Ref. Min. 107/17(b))

A price for a new seat had been sought and it was reported that it would cost in the region of £25. It was also reported that the window was rotten and was in need of replacement. A quote of £120 to supply only had been received but it was noted that it was necessary to be FENSA registered in order to fit. It was, therefore, agreed to seek tenders to supply and fit from the following: Ian Ward, Jason Samuel, Darren Prosser and N.R. Hope & Sons.

(c) Newbridge-on-Wye Recycling Site (Ref. Min. 107/17(c))

Nothing further to report.

(d) Llanyre Recreation Field:

- (i) Recreation Field (Ref. Min. 107/17(d)) – no further investigations had been carried out to date and it was agreed to wait until the drier weather.
- (ii) Play Area (Ref. Min. 107/17(d)) – it was noted that the wood chippings from the fallen tree had been spread on the path in Pritchard Recreation Ground.

- (iii) Pritchard Recreation Ground (Ref. Min. 107/17(d)) – the remedial works on the drainage have not worked and the Local Member was requested to inform Powys County Council accordingly.
- (e) Newbridge-on-Wye Playing Field (Ref. Min. 107/17(e)) – it was reported that the moles were again proving to be problematic and it was agreed that the Clerk write again to Powys County Council.

Members queried the cost of the electricity at Newbridge-on-Wye toilets compared to the costs for Llanyre. It was noted that the fountain, Christmas lights and the lamp on the Village Green were all connected to the electricity supply for the toilets and this could contribute to the higher costs. It was agreed to monitor the situation.

124/18 CORRESPONDENCE

- (a) **Teenage Cancer Trust** - On reference from the last meeting further consideration was given to a request for financial assistance from the Teenage Cancer Trust. Following discussion, it was agreed to defer a decision until the next meeting.
- (b) **Local Democracy and Boundary Commission for Wales** – Review of the Electoral Arrangements for the County of Powys. Draft Proposals were received and the report distributed to Members for their information.

125/18 LOCAL MEMBER UP-DATE

- Speed awareness training had recently taken place in Newbridge-on-Wye and it was noted that the Police were going to undertake testing in Llanyre on 31st March.
- A new committee has been established to organise Llanyre Show which will be held on Saturday, 4th August.
- Further contact has been made with the Trunk Road Agency and the Welsh Assembly regarding the extending of the lay-by opposite the Post Office in Newbridge-on-Wye. It was reported that major works are currently being prioritised by need and this project does not rank highly enough at present.
- The deterioration of the road to Dollwynhir was brought to the Member's attention.
- The Local Member was requested to make further enquiries regarding the replacement of the felt on the roof of the bus shelter adjacent to Llwyncelyn.
