053/19	<p>MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: The notes of the Ordinary Meeting of 21st April 2019 were approved and signed as a true record (PS/LS)</p>
053/19a	The Minutes of the Annual Meeting held on 21 st May 2019 were approved and signed as a true record (PS/LS)
054/19	<p>MATTERS ARISING (from the Previous Meeting)</p> <p>(a) Public Toilets, Llanyre (Ref. Min. 034/19(a))</p> <p>Electricity – 45458 Water – 671</p> <p>Members had visited the site to assess the repairs required to the concrete – it was suggested that the concrete could be replaced by slabs at the road end. It was proposed that members should contact potential contractors to get quotes. Cllr Mills suggested contacting Jamie’s Garden Services (Clerk to contact). Cllr Smith would get a further quote and pass this to the clerk.</p> <p>(b) Public Toilets, Newbridge-on-Wye (Ref. Min. 034/19(b))</p> <p>Electricity – 442 Water – 3894 6654 Cllr Mills advised that the ladies toilets were not very clean and had a stale smell. It was agreed that the clerk should check the cost of deep cleaning and dates of the previous deep cleans</p> <p>(c) Newbridge-on-Wye Recycling Site (Ref. Min. 034/19(c))</p> <p>The site continues to be tidy and in good order.</p> <p>(d) Llanyre Recreation Field:</p> <p>(i) Recreation Field (Ref. Min. 034/19(d)) –no report on the progress of contacting the neighbouring land owner about boundary fences. A perimeter path to allow easier access for walkers had been mowed by</p>

	<p>a resident and was being well used. HL reported that a local contractor could top the field for approximately £80, Baling the field was again discussed and SDP agreed to contact a potential contractor for costs. It was suggested that there should be a bin by the entrance gate. Cllr Mills offered to contact PCC to enquire about this. LS reported that the latching post at the entrance to the field was rotting at the bottom. It was suggested that replacing this could be included in the quote for works for the toilets.</p> <p>(ii) Play Area (Ref. Min. 034/19(d)) –MW suggested that it may be safer if the gate to the play area opened inward to slow children from running towards the road. Cllr Mills to contact Steve Gealey about this. It was again noted that some of the play equipment looked shabby, a tidy up event was proposed. Cr Mills agreed to contact local people with a view to having a tidy up day on 13TH July. It was suggested that a renovation fund should be discussed at a future meeting. HL reported that the new heavy duty picnic bench had been delivered and located on site by Caefagu Products costing and a discount on the purchase price had been given. The bench was now secured in situ. It was proposed that a letter of thanks be sent to John Jones at Caefague for their help and discount.</p> <p>(e) Pritchard Recreation Ground (Ref. 055/19	<p>LOCAL MEMBER UP-DATE</p> <p>There had been several speed watch checks in Llanyre with speeds through the village of 52mph recorded. Anyone who received 2 letters as a consequence of having been recorded driving in excess of 36 mph would receive a police visit. It was hoped that the police would shortly provide a calibrated speed recording device that would enable prosecutions. NoW speed signs are now in place. A meeting will take place with PCC on 20th June to discuss signs on the b roads. The show programmes will be deliver in the coming week. Cllr Mills had been with a resident to view drains in Llanyre, these have been cleared twice by PCC. It is likely that the drain by the Bell Inn will be improved. Cllr Mills left at 8.10 pm.</p>
