044/21	<p><b>MATTERS ARISING from the Previous Meeting):</b></p> <p>(a) Public Toilets, Llanyre and Newbridge-on-Wye had remained closed. Re-opening the toilets was discussed. To provide information for an interested member there was a short overview of the outcome of the review regarding cleaning costs undertaken before Covid. There was a need to pay minimum wage to an employed cleaner or to put a contract out to tender. It was noted that the current budget for running the toilets (including cleaning) was £2,450. <b>Clerk to revise the reviewed costs.</b></p> <p>(b) Newbridge-on-Wye Recycling Site – no issues</p> <p>(c)</p> <p>(i) Llanyre Recreation Field and Pritchard’s Patch: A resident (Name and address supplied) advised that a redundant metal diversion sign had been acquired to adapt as an Information Board for Pritchard’s Patch. Dr Fred Slater had updated his plant list for the sign, a talented resident will do the artwork and Sayce's will do the printing for a reasonable price - the info can be levered off when it needs replacing. Mr Pritchard's wishes will be respected regarding the wording. Members noted this with thanks. Correspondence had also advised vegetation around the double gates overgrown ; church end path is very overgrown,. The offer was received with thanks. HL to co-ordinate.</p> <p>e) Cut and Baling the recreation field. <b>SDP to contact local farmer.</b></p> <p>f) SSE smart meters – agreed to allow fitting of smart meters at the toilets if available SJ to be NoW and HL to be Llanyre contacts for installers.</p>
