As wreaths for this year had been ordered from Royal British Legion. It was proposed to offer the ‘saved’ wreaths to local children/youth groups to encourage participation in the Remembrance ceremony. The use of fresh flowers and/or the recycling re-use of plastic wreaths to be considered at a future meeting. SJ advised that the lamp post poppies used in NoW needed to be replaced it was agreed to allocate £45.00 to be given as donation in exchange for 15 new poppies. SJ to organise and be refunded on receipt of invoice/receipt for payment. b) Christmas Lights: clerk advised that the disputed bills from SSE for 2028/19 and 2019/20 had been revised and a payment of £21.88 made. LS to arrange installation of lights in Llanyre. Clerk was authorised to agree supply access with Western Power when received. c) HSBC dormant accounts progress – HSBC had advised that Llanyre Recreation Ground Account would be re-opened by Mid November. Clerk had requested that they continue to work towards the opening of the Turbaries account.
